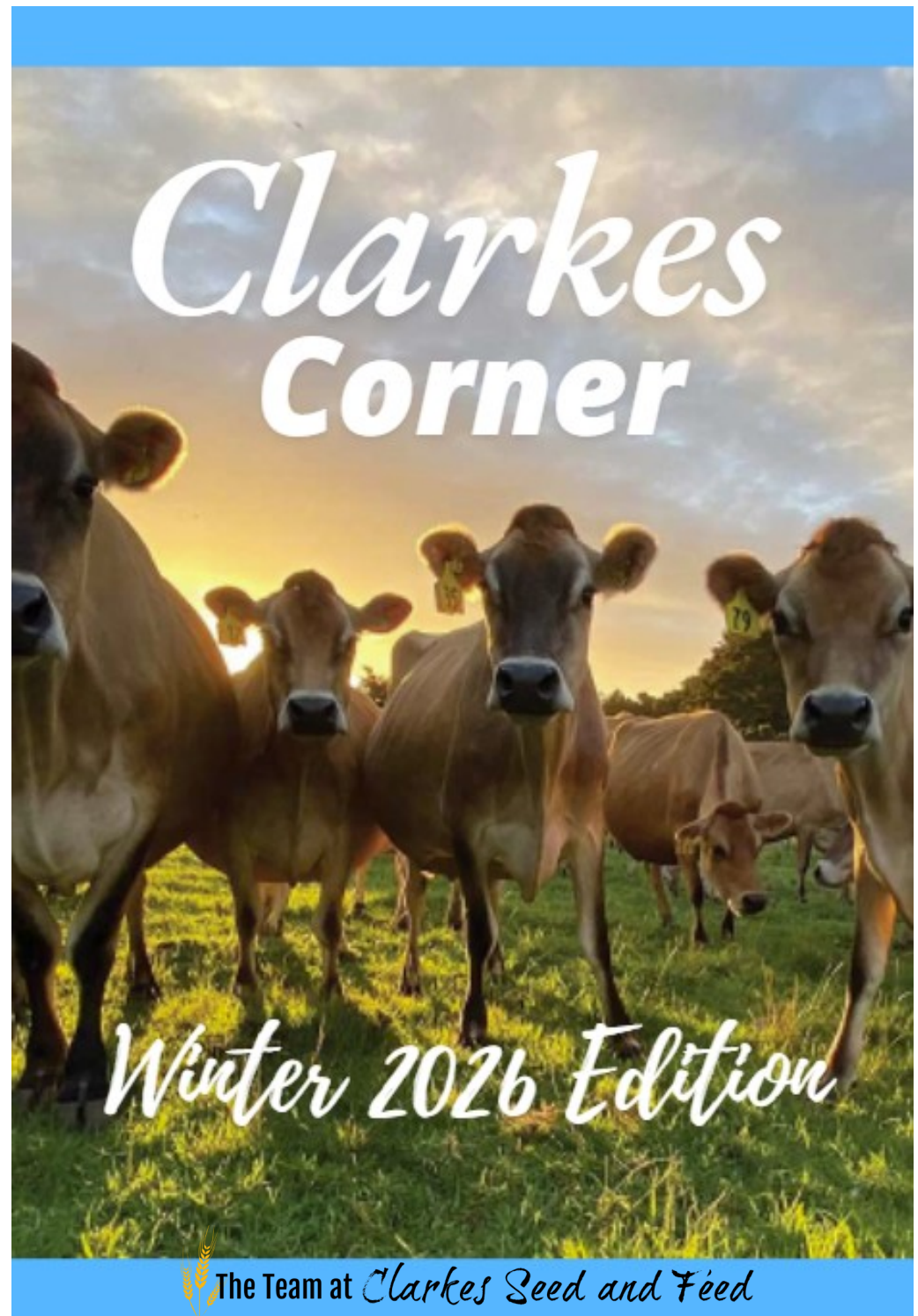
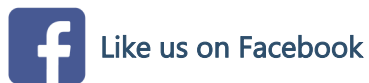

A WORD FROM

At the time of writing most herds are in the process of drying off with good weather conditions extending some milking for the short term.

Generally good Autumn growth has lead to improved cow condition at dry off.

National Field days are not far off (10-13 June) with many holding out for some sharp PKE & commodity pricing (at writing PKE Spot approx \$445) . We will be contacting all clients in the coming days to advise expectations & gauge requirements.

Milk Replacers have also firmed but we will be offering our normal Early Bird Deals due out soon so watch this space or contact the store for some of the best pricing out there.

Lastly a later than normal harvest is now complete with good quality (although more drying than usual) and on average some very good yields at least locally.

The wetter harvest in Canterbury has downgraded some milling wheat & malting barley to feed lots as well. Pressure has come on pricing though with fuel & fertiliser costs dramatically increased. In general get feed orders for grain in asap to help limit the potential lift. We wish you well for the coming winter & look forward to seeing you soon.
